Smells meaty, animal, saucisson. Raspberry. This is fantastic. Explodes across the mouth, beautiful whirling acidity with prune and dried damsons and raspberries and souk spice – sumac and cinnamon, white pepper, pomegranates. So vital, so alive, layered and complex and this kaleidoscope of spices. Yet the fruit is pure and sappy and flows through those dusty, fragrant, crazy spices with great contentment. Long, fine and fragrant on the finish, Dry, spliced, upright tannins. Walnuts. Very very good. (TC)
