Inky, sweet Cab Franc. The tannins are pretty hefty and there is a lot of oak, giving it an almost bourbon-like flavour on the finish. Leather and cigar, mainly. It feels as if the winemaking is obscuring the fruit and freshness, which is a real shame because the glimpses I get of the fruit are pretty good. (TC)
